Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9

God is in control. This is a tremendous reassurance for us at any time, but even more so as we travel through a world turned sideways because of viruses, divisive politics, and violent protests. The world does not seem like a safe place for a Cadet-aged boy.

God's promise to Joshua, and His promise to us, is that He will be with us through all situations. He did not promise it would be easy.
